Dear Sir or Madam.

The Dodd-Frank Act requires companies that are listed on the U.S. stock exchange to provide disclosures about the use of "conflict minerals" originating from the Democratic Republic of the Congo and adjoining countries. In Section 1502 of the Dodd-Frank Act, the U.S. federal government defines the following minerals and their derivatives as "conflict minerals": columbite-tantalite, cassiterite, wolframite and gold.

WAGO primarily processes tin and gold from the defined minerals. Additionally, columbite-tantalite and wolframite may also be a constitutive part of our products. WAGO's suppliers are required not to use or procure raw material from regions or countries that give cause for serious ethical and/or environmental concern. Therefore, there is no reason to believe that "conflict minerals," which have been illegally mined to finance armed groups, are contained in our products.

WAGO is closely monitoring further developments in this field and will respond accordingly in a timely manner to possible additional requirements.
